In addition, free musical entertainment on several stages, activities for the children, pony rides, Farmers' Market, and over forty local non-profit exhibitors all make for a great day in the country, in a town renowned for its Victorian charm and agricultural bounty.

The festival is produced by the Warwick Valley Chamber of Commerce, which is a full-service business development and marketing organization dedicated to helping businesses in the Town of Warwick, NY, as well as the surrounding areas, reach their full potential. 
